



Year 13 Key Dates



All exam entries and post results are made by Mr P Jones or Miss N Hankey. In Penglais we have up to 900 students sitting exams. You only have to think about your exams so you must take responsibility. Mr Jones and Miss Hankey have other responsibilities in school in addition to exams so do not leave things to the last minute and do not assume they will be available in their office. Most problems are avoided if you ask in good time.

- 1) Deadline for GCE priority review of marking 22nd August £50.50p each (WJEC) + £12 for photocopy of script.
- 2) Deadline for ordering priority scripts back 22nd August. Cost is £12 per paper (WJEC).
- 3) Deadline for non-priority review of marking 19th September £43 each (WJEC) + £12 for photocopy of script.
- 4) Deadline for ordering non-priority scripts back 26th September. Cost is £12 per paper (WJEC).
- 5) Cambridge Assessment for BMAT (medicine, vet school, biomed) Entry window 1st September– 1st October. Cost £48 payable by candidate. Exam Wednesday 30th October 9am in the Main Hall – this is during half term.
- 6) Cambridge Admissions Testing Service – Includes History Aptitude Test, Geography aptitude test, Physics Aptitude Test, Oxford Thinking Skills Assessment Entry window 1st September – 15th October (no charge for candidates) . YOU NEED YOUR UCAS NUMBER to make an entry. Exam date is Wednesday 30th October 9am in the Main Hall – this is during half term.
- 7) Maths linear GCSE re-sit deadline is early – September 30th. You must pay before the entry goes in (£38.76)
- 8) January GCSE exam re-sits (e.g. English literacy) – deadline is October 18th . You must pay before the entry goes in.
- 9) Summer exam entries are made in January. A draft exam timetable will be printed at the start of February. If any changes need to be made it is your responsibility to do this **well before** the deadline of February 10th . If you dropped a subject after Year 12 OR are studying for an AS subject in Year 13 YOU MUST see Mr Jones or Miss Hankey to make a cash in entry before February 10th if you intend to receive a final grade for it. There is no ‘automatic’ cash in for modular courses.
- 10) November GCSE results are available on January 16th. If you intend to re-sit any of these you have very little time to check fees, bring in payment and have the entry made. Late fees are double cost for WJEC. You must move quickly on these.
- 11) Maths STEP entry window is 26th February – 26th April. Cost is £50 payable by candidate. Don't leave to the deadline. STEP 1 exam 10th June, STEP 2 17th June, STEP 3 21st June.
- 12) GCE results are available in school on Thursday 13th August, between 08.30am – 11.00am. You are strongly advised to collect these results in school as staff will be available to help if required. Results will not be e-mailed or given out over the telephone. Use the priority script 7 day window to order scripts if you are unsure why you got the grade you got – this means the script can be checked before deciding on any review of marking.



Year 12 Key Dates



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- 1) Deadline for ordering GCSE priority scripts back 29th August. Cost is £12 per paper (WJEC).
- 2) Deadline for GCSE review of marking is 19th September £37.50 per paper + £12 per paper if you want the script back (WJEC). You must see your teachers in the first 2 weeks of September to review your marks and check the grade boundaries before making a decision. Remember marks and grades could go up, stay the same or go down – you keep the result of a review of marking. Payment is required before requests are processed.
- 3) Deadline for ordering non-priority scripts back 26th September. Cost is £12 per paper (WJEC). Payment is required before requests are processed.
Nothing can be done after these dates
- 4) Maths linear GCSEs re-sit deadline is early – September 30th . Discuss this with the department first. Unless you are registered and taught in a timetabled class for this then you must pay £38.76 before the entry is put in.
- 5) January GCSE exam re-sits (e.g. Legacy series) – deadline is October 20th . You must pay before the entry goes in.
- 6) Summer exam entries are made in January. A draft exam timetable and statement of entry will be printed at the start of February. If any changes need to be made it is your responsibility to do this **well before** the exams staff deadline of February 10th.
- 7) GCE results are available in school on Thursday 13th August, between 08.30am– 11.00am. You are strongly advised to collect these results in school as staff will be available to help if required. Results will not be e- mailed or given out over the telephone. You can use priority script recall for 7 days after the results day.

Aim to pass your GCE exams at the first time of asking, re-sits are expensive and they are only available in the Summer exam series. Re-sits also use up a lot of time and effort you could be spending on your Year 13 studies. Be aware that if you repeat a year and wish to sit a unit for a third time this will trigger a 'fresh start' and you will have to sit all the units in the same season, and these results will be the ones used in awarding an overall grade. Also, be aware that some universities and some courses **DO NOT** accept any re-sit results.



Year 11 Key Dates



All exam entries and post results are made by Mr P Jones and Miss N Hankey. In Penglais we have up to 900 students sitting exams per year. You only have to think about your exams so you must take responsibility. Mr Jones and Miss Hankey have other responsibilities in school in addition to exams so do not leave things to the last minute and do not assume they will be available in their office. Most problems are avoided if you ask in good time.

- 1) Deadline for priority electronic copy of scripts 29th August. Cost is £12 per paper (WJEC).
- 2) Deadline for GCSE re-marks 19th September, cost is £36 per paper (WJEC) + £12 per paper if you want a copy of your script (WJEC). You must see your teachers in the first 2 weeks of September to review your marks and check the grade boundaries before making a decision. Remember marks and grades could go up, stay the same or go down – you keep the result of the re-mark. Payment is required before requests are processed.
- 3) Deadline for ordering non-priority scripts back 29th September, cost is £12 per paper (WJEC). Payment is required before requests are processed.
Nothing can be done after these dates
- 4) January exams – Only a few subjects offer re-sits in January e.g. English Literature, Health and Social Care. The deadline is October 20th. You must pay before the entry goes in. You will have science practical exams.
- 5) Summer exam entries are made in January. For modular courses you will be able to re-sit units taken in Year 10 but this will have an impact on your Year 11 work. A draft exam timetable and statement of entry will be printed off and given to you at the start of February. If any changes need to be made it is your responsibility to do this and see Mr Jones or Miss Hankey **well before** the exams staff deadline of February 10th. You need to check for any entries not needed, any missing entries and entries at the wrong tier. Any changes after this date will be at your own expense.
- 6) GCSE results are available in school on Thursday 20th August, between 08.30am– 11.00am. You are strongly advised to collect these results in school as staff will be available to help if required. You will also be able to check overall marks and grade boundaries on this morning. You have 7 days from results day to order and pay for priority scripts – this allows you to check your work before deciding on any review of marking. Results will not be e-mailed or given out over the telephone.

Aim to pass your Year 11 exams at the first time of asking, re-sits are expensive and use up a lot of time and effort you could be spending on your Year 12 studies if you choose to re-sit any next year.



Year 10 Key Dates



All exam entries and post results are made by Mr P Jones and Miss N Hankey. In Penglais we have up to 900 students sitting exams per year. Mr Jones and Miss Hankey have other responsibilities in school in addition to exams so do not leave things to the last minute and do not assume they will be available in their office. Most problems are avoided if you ask in good time.

- 1) In Year 10 you only have one exam season – this is the Summer exam season. Entries are made in January. A draft exam timetable and statement of entry will be printed and given to you at the start of February. If any changes need to be made it is your responsibility to do this **well before** the exams staff deadline of February 10th. You need to check for any entries not needed, any missing entries and entries at the wrong tier. If you wish to take an exam in a subject you are not taught here this may be possible, but see Mr Jones or Miss Hankey in good time – do this during January. You will be expected to pay the costs of any exam entries for additional subjects.
- 2) Your exam results at the end of Year 10 will be unit marks and grades (marks and grades for each unit completed). You can collect these results on the morning of GCSE Results' Day (Thursday 20th August).
You are strongly advised to collect these results in school as staff will be available to help if required.
Results will not be e- mailed or given out over the telephone.

You will have a lot of controlled assessment to complete in Years 10 and 11. The better you do in these the better your final grade is likely to be.

Aim to pass your Year 10 exams at the first time of asking, re-sits are expensive and use up a lot of time and effort you could be spending on your Year 11 studies.

Enquiries About Results (EAR) Services

These are services provided AFTER results have been received, and usually fall into 2 categories. For both services you are required to pay before any requests are processed. If cheques are used please make payable to 'CCC' (Ceredigion County Council). Add the students' name to the back of the cheques. Students need to see Mr P Jones or Miss N Hankey for any requests to be processed.

- 1) Apply for a review of marking - this should be discussed with the department first and should only be considered if you are close to moving up a grade. **Please note that a mark can only be changed if the review finds clear evidence of failure to follow the mark scheme in the original mark.** Be aware that with a review of marking the mark could go up, stay the same or go down. Grades may go up, stay the same or down. The grade after the review of marking is the grade you keep. With Year 13 exams in the Summer you can request a PRIORITY review of marking if a place at university is at stake (this is usually completed within 1 week). In Year 13 if you are considering a review of marking then the application should go in as a Priority service.
- 2) Buy back your script. This service allows you to go through your paper with your teacher to help your learning . With Priority scripts you will receive a copy of your exam paper before the deadline for re-marks – these are available for all GCE written papers. At GCSE these are not available for all subjects before deciding on re-mark.

The deadlines for these services for 2019-20 are below. Final dates for the summer exam series will be confirmed before Results' days.

Please be aware that no post results services are available after the deadlines.
